INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS (Dry Back Vinyl)

Preparations:

The surface of the floor must be completely dry. Moisture testing is a mandatory step for subfloor preparations.
A fully functioning HVAC system is required to control both temperature and humidity

- 2. In a newly constructed building it is necessary to dry the flooring surface for 7 to 14 days prior to application to ensure that no moisture is retained in cement surfaces.
- 3. Any polish, paint, dirt, etc. must be completely removed from the floor before installation. Dry mop and sweep the entire floor to remove surface sand, soil and debris.
- 4. Ensure that the floor surface is flat and level. Use a scraper to flatten the floor surface or a putty knife to remove gum and / or labels.
- 5. Maintain the room temperature above 15°C (59°F) before installation. Adhesive and flooring product must be kept in the same environment for at least 24 hours prior to the installation.

Installation

- 1. Check that all application products are of the same batch / lot number.
- 2. Find the exact center of the floor by marking vertical and horizontal lines across the floor.
- 3. Measure the squareness of the marked lines, and then start

applying adhesives on the first quarter of the marked floor space.

- 4. Work on small portions of the floor at a time, and apply adhesives. Optimum usage of adhesive is 0.3 to 0.45 kg per square meter.
- 5. Lay the flooring product approximately 20 to 30 minutes after applying adhesive.
- 6. Keep a distance of 1 mm from the wall and the edge of the flooring product. Press product down firmly so that the product lies flat on the ground.
- 7. As the adhesives are highly flammable, avoid any contact with sparks or open flames.
- 8. As the adhesives dry quickly, remove excess adhesive immediately by using alcohol or alkali water.
